



Privacy Notice to Members on behalf of The Old Petriburgians' Association (OPA)

The purpose of this notice is to deal with the new General Data Protection Regulation which came into force on 25 May 2018 and which in ordinary circumstances requires every person whose data is held by a third-party to give their physical and positive acquiescence in the use of that data by any such third party.

The Old Petriburgians' Association only holds members' data for the purpose of communicating with those members who have given their physical and positive acquiescence in advance. Data is restricted to those members who were contacted before 25 May 2018 and gave their assent by that date, or who have given their assent since. No data is held on other members.

1. You are advised of the Data Controller from time to time. Currently, the Data Controller is the OPA Treasurer, Rachael Dudley, who can be contacted at dudley.r@kings.peterborough.sch.uk.
2. That the purpose for which the data will be processed is for the circulation of information to members.
3. That the data will not be transferred to any other organisation.
4. That subject access requests can be made on application to the Treasurer or to the Chairman of the Association.
5. That complaints can be addressed to the Information Commissioner's Office.
6. That you have the right to deletion, restriction or amendment of your data.
7. That the data will be deleted upon request.
8. That there are no circumstances in which the data will be transferred out of the European Economic Community (except by the United Kingdom completing Brexit in which case the legislation will be replicated in United Kingdom legislation).
9. That members will have the option at all times requiring their details to be actually deleted or amended without delay.
10. That a member's personal data will not be transferred or indirectly made available to sponsors or other third parties without specific informed opt-in consent.

On the above basis this is a Privacy Notice in relation to your data to comply with the terms of the General Data Protection Regulation.
