Placement: Tuesday 8 July - Friday 11 July

Monitoring:

Staff will call your placement (or email if there is no reply) on the first day to check on your attendance. Further monitoring will happen later in the week as staff will either call a second time or visit you.

Illness:

If you are unable to attend your placement your parents must report your absence to school in the normal way and you must call your placement to ensure they are aware of your absence. This must happen each day that you are absent.
