Uniform and Appearance

In appreciation of the closure of non-essential shops during lock down we have been lenient in terms of enforcing some of our uniform requirements. We feel that it is now time to remind students of our expectations both in terms of the correct uniform and appearance. I would especially like to remind them of the following:

- Coats and outerwear should be a plain black, dark grey or navy - a coat, raincoat or anorak without logos (bar the school crest). No fashion, denim or leather coats are acceptable, for example, hoodies
- Shoes should be plain black - not suede or canvas, or boots
- Extreme hairstyles and unnatural hair colours are not acceptable
- Boys hair must be above collar length
- Facial hair is not acceptable other than on religious grounds

Students will be reminded of these requirements by their tutors next week and we will ask for compliance by the end of the month.
