Dear Parents & Carers,

Please read this carefully, as I'm afraid I made some errors with dates last week. Hopefully this letter will set things right.

Correction to SRE Dates

SRE (Sex and Relationships education) will take place on 13 and 14 July, and not on 12 and 13 July as previously sent home. The correct dates are included below.

SRE will take place in JD2, but will be delivered by JD staff taking the role usually filled by the School Nurse. This will take place in several stages:

- 13 July - Year 5 and 6 girls will have a lesson about Menstruation with Miss Martin
- 13 July - Year 6 Pupils will learn about 'changes' to the body, including puberty, with Mr Ludford
- 14 July - Year 6 Pupils will learn about conception and birth with Mr Ludford

We use a DVD resource called 'Living And Growing', produced by Channel 4, to support the work, and we ensure pupils have the opportunity to raise questions discreetly. If parents have any questions about these sessions, please contact Mr Ludford directly.

Friday 9 July - JD1 Hunstanton Trip

8.15am arrival at JD, collection 4.30pm from the tower entrance

Monday 12 July - JD2 Hiking Day (Borough Hill Fort)

Arrive and collect at normal School time.

For both these trips, pupils should wear sturdy, non-uniform clothing, but with their school hoody to help us identify them. They will need to bring the following items in a small backpack, which they are responsible for carrying throughout the day:

- Water bottle
- Facemask
- Packed lunch and snacks (the snacks can be treats, e.g. biscuit/cake, but no chocolate bars or sweets please)
- Lightweight waterproof jacket/cagoule
- Sturdy trainers/hiking boots
- Plastic carrier bag
- Appropriate sun equipment, e.g. cap and sun cream
- JD1 pupils are encouraged to bring a small plastic beach bucket and plastic spade if they have them

We will carry communal hand sanitiser, but it is helpful if pupils carry their own small bottle with them. Pupils are welcome to bring a book, notebook and pencil or simple games (e.g. top trumps) to play during the journey. These items can be left on the coach whilst we take part in the day's activities.

Leavers' Service (Year 6) - Friday 16 July

1.30pm start, JD gates open at 1.15pm. At this point in time, we are working to provide a Leavers' Service to mark the departure of our lovely Year 6 pupils. Our current intention is to hold an open-air service at JD, on Friday 16 July starting at 1.30pm. Parents of Year 6 would need to wear face coverings to arrive and depart, and would be allocated a space in which to sit for the service. Parents will need to bring their own folding chairs and stick strictly to the spacing requirements. If you are a Year 6 parent attending the service, you will be free to take your Year 6 child home with you at the end of the service. At this point we are limiting numbers to 2 adults per child.
