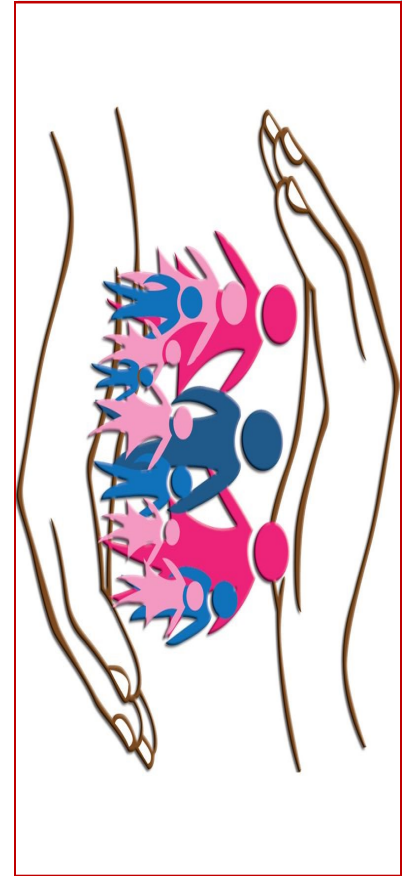

RECENT SAFEGUARDING TRAINING

It is our statutory obligation to remain up to date with safeguarding issues. All new staff and governors receive an hour-long Safeguarding and Child Protection training session, and current staff and governors a September update. As Prevent Lead I have attended three courses and written a School Prevent Action Plan. Prevent is a Government strategy designed to fight extremism and associated radicalisation. I have cascaded my training to all staff.
