They began their day by walking from school to the Peterborough museum.

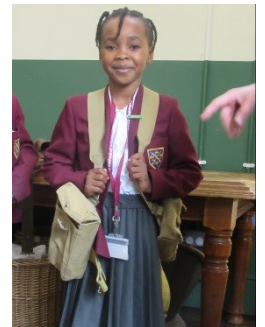
