



SPORT PREMIUM 2014-2015

Sport Premium is allocated to primary schools, depending on the number of pupils on roll. The King's (The Cathedral) School received £8310 during this academic year. Schools are free to determine their own spending, seeking to improve the quality of Physical Education provision.

In 2014-2015, The King's (The Cathedral) School, Peterborough spent the money to:

- Provide access to top-quality PE facilities beyond what is normally available to Primary students e.g. Sports Hall, bicycles, Fitness Room and equipment.
- Ensure enhanced provision, beyond the National Curriculum, through the use of highly-skilled and qualified specialist PE teachers in Junior Department lessons, to develop skills and enhance athletic ability.(This is not to cover PPA-release.)
- Provide enhanced opportunities for swimming, with longer and more numerous sessions, with multiple swimming coaches allowing specialist tuition, smaller groups, better access and hence enhanced skills development.
- Provide transport and staffing to access inter-school sports events and competitions, for individuals and year-groups, including Cathedral Choristers, to work alongside and compete with pupils from other primary schools e.g. Quicksticks and Bikeability.
- Provide transport for outdoor and adventurous activities, e.g. JD2 hiking days.
- Provide a JD specialist summer Sports Day, including track marking.
- Purchase resources promoting sport at JD, some of the budget under the control of the JD Student Council.

SPORT PREMIUM 2015-2016

We intend to continue with the same programme of enhanced provision, dependant on funding available. At the same time we are looking to:

- a) Broaden the number of inter-school events and competitions in which we can take part.
- b) Involve the Cathedral Choristers in Choir Schools' Association inter-cathedral sport.
- c) As part of their adventurous activities, take JD1 on a visit to Go Ape.
