Cross-Country

JD2 Anglian Water Recycling Plant Visit - Friday 15 March

JD2 pupils will be visiting the Water Recycling Plant at Deeping St James as part of their topic work. This unusual visit has been made possible by the hard work of Mr Pluke, who has opened the plant especially for our pupils.

Pupils will travel in minibuses with Mr Ludford and JD staff, and will be shown around the plant to see how the waste water and sewage are processed and cleaned. They will be able to see the process from the point of entry to the plant, until the water is clean enough to be put back into the nearby River Welland.

We will then visit the Deepings Lakes Nature Reserve, where we will eat our packed lunches, and look at how the wildlife is able to live in the river area following treatment. Otters live in that section of the river, and pupils are welcome to bring binoculars (at their own risk) just in case we are lucky enough to spot some.

Pupils should come to school dressed in the same 'active clothing' they would wear if we were hiking; all pupils must be wearing long trousers and sturdy footwear to meet the safety requirements for the trip. A waterproof coat is essential, and they need a packed lunch and water bottle as well. We will be wearing protective gloves during our visit, and are well equipped with hand sanitiser.
